VIDEOAUDIO

Westside WPC clinic shots in folder: "WPC Patty Heaton Promo"
Preferably uses shots that we haven't used.

SHOTS of women at the clinic being helped, Use as many shots from "WPC Patty Heaton Promo" that we haven't used. You can use one or two that we have used in the Heaton promo because this will provide a sense of continuity with that video.

SHOW NARRATOR walking through the clinic (Steady-cam)

NARRATOR leaves the office and shuts door, focus in on WPC sign.

TRANSITION

NARRATOR:

The Westside Pregnancy Clinic became a fully licensed medical clinic in 2004.

With the help of supporters like you, we have served thousands of men, women and unborn children by providing free pregnancy tests, ultrasounds and other medical resources and education.

Hundreds of those who came through our doors thought abortion was their only option.

We educated them about the alternatives, and provided help for the choices they made.

By standing, alongside you, as the only life-affirming clinic of our kind in West Los Angeles we are saving and changing lives.

But our vision does not stop here.

SHOTS of Crenshaw district from New footage we shot.

SHOTS TO MATCH:

African Americans, Poverty, Teens etc. Stock photos?

SHOW NARRATOR standing. Behind her, the fence, gate and street of Crenshaw. Handheld.

NARRATOR walks (Steady-cam)

NARRATOR walks up to front door of Crenshaw Clinic (Steadicam)

NARRATOR walks into the new Crenshaw Clinic, focus in on new window sign.

AUDIO

In 2008, we identified the Crenshaw District of South Los Angeles as the targeted area for our first satellite clinic expansion.

Why? Because research shows this community has the highest concentration of African Americans in the area. And African Americans are five times more likely than Caucasians to have an abortion -- five times more likely.

This community is also hardest hit by poverty, teen pregnancy, drug addiction and sexually transmitted infections.

By June of 2009, we were able to raise close to 50,000 dollars to cover initial expenses and secure our South Los Angeles Clinic location.

But we had our work cut out for us.

MONTAGE OF OPEN HOUSE:

Tera does a walk through, explaining the rooms.

Quick cuts to see each room as she intros it...

We see Dilapidated floors and walls...

VIDEO

Use footage from "Day 1 - Writing on Wall" folder. People write on the wall their blessings and Bible verses. Some small kids do so as well, drawing a pregnant stick figure. Then cut to the painters painting over the walls from the folder: "" It's okay if we run overtime related to the narration, just put in music underneath to accent.

NARRATOR:

In the Ultrasound room, our supporters wrote their hopes and prayers on the wall as a foundational start for a life changing impact on the community.

With volunteer help from local contractors, church contacts, and people like you and me, renovation was completed in October, enabling us to provide quality care for the South LA low-income and at-risk population -- care that the Westside Pregnancy Clinic is already known for.

The South Los Angeles clinic opened for service to the Crenshaw community in September 2009.

And we continue to establish relationships with community-based organizations, schools and other agencies in the area.

Together, we will actively address the high risk behaviors relating to sexual health, as well as the growing rate of teen pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections -- through intervention, prevention, and direct services.

Our goal is that with the help of ongoing volunteers and charitable giving, we will be able to reach the at-risk individuals of the community and continue to provide ongoing free medical services, sexual health education, and other pregnancy and parenting programs.
